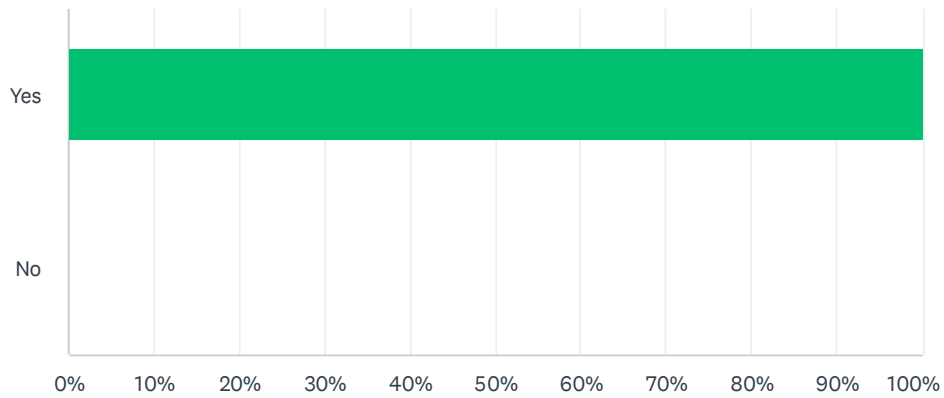


Q1 I know the mission of our board and I can communicate it to others.

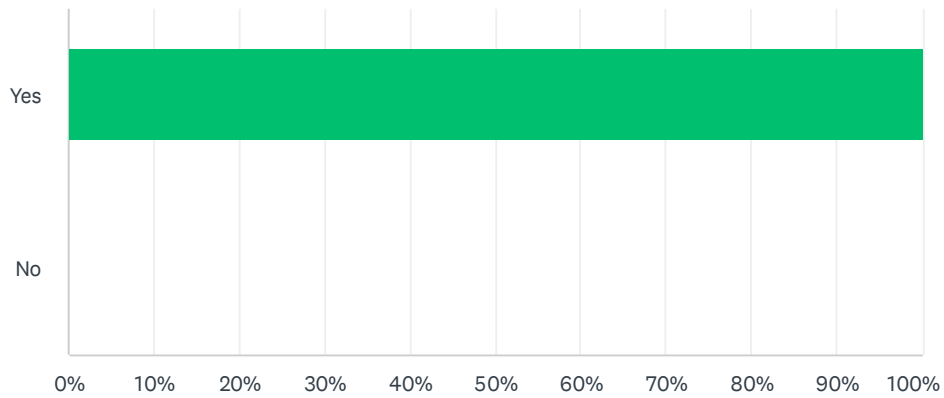
