
**TFF Staff Comments**: Action Brown County has received multiple Capacity Building, Matching, and Formal Funding grants over

multiple years. Most recently, they received \$25,000 for the Business Innovation Competition and \$35,000 for General Operating Support in 2023.

The Rink @ Uptown Mt. Sterling is a pro-active project of TFF. The TFF staff and Susie Stamerjohn were heavily involved from idea to execution. TFF Staff support renting the rink one more year but believe that if the season is successful again that we should consider purchasing the rink.

The TFF Board is reviewing this application because it is for more than \$50,000.

Request Information: We are requesting \$93,700 to pay for the rental of the ice rink and the rental of the

American Legion building for The Rink @ Uptown Mt. Sterling. The project was a huge success last year and we expect this upcoming season to be bigger and better. The ice rink would grow in size from 80'x30' to 80'x45'. In addition, we will add more skate assists, food options, and other enhancements to continue to grow this unique Brown

County attraction.

Need for Project: There are few unique Brown County attractions that bring people to Mt. Sterling to

experience the community, shop, and eat. The Brown County Fair attracts thousands of people each year, but the crowds are concentrated at the fairgrounds and do not experience other parts of the community. The Rink @ Uptown Mt. Sterling attracts people to the uptown district at the doorstep of Hagel 1891, Brews, Simply Shiloh, and

the other businesses that Mt. Sterling has to offer.

Best Practices: Last year The Rink @ Uptown Mt. Sterling attracted more than 5,000 skaters from 134

different zip codes who consumed more than 2,663 cups of hot chocolate. We're confident that the rink will be bigger and better this year and will attract even more skaters. We're also confident that we'll attract more business sponsors and supporters

with the demonstrated success of last year.

**Collaboration:** It took hundreds of Brown County volunteers and a strong collaboration from the Tracy Family Foundation, Action Brown County, and many Brown County community leaders

to pull off the Rink @ Uptown Mt. Sterling. A steering committee for this year's rink has

already begun to meet.

Action Brown County's mission to inspire community, celebrate Hornet spirit, and promote economic growth. The Rink is an ideal strategy towards this mission. The Rink

brought the whole Region together, provided significant pride for Brown County residents, and drove economic development for local businesses.

for ABC's work in Brown County.
